Success Academy Expands Opportunities for Calhoun County Youth!

In April 2023, United Way of East Central Alabama took a major step toward empowering local youth by acquiring Success Academy—a youth diversion program that provides critical support for students navigating academic, personal, and mental health challenges. Success Academy's mission is to equip students in grades 7 through 12 who are involved with the juvenile justice system with tools for resilience and readiness to thrive as they transition into adulthood.

At Success Academy, students receive therapeutic care, academic remediation, school credit recovery, and essential life skills. By helping these young people regain their footing, the program opens doors to brighter futures and empowers them to overcome past setbacks. Through this initiative, United Way is furthering its commitment to ensure every young person has access to opportunities that promote growth and self-sufficiency.

Our dedication was recently recognized by the Alabama Department of Youth Services' Diversion Program Evaluation, where Success Academy earned a **95% successful completion rate**—a testament to the program's positive impact. Since then, this initiative has seen over 50 local students graduate the program!

On July 22, 2024, we reached an exciting milestone as we cut the ribbon on Success Academy's newly renovated location. This new space, outfitted with updated equipment and designed for comfort, provides students with the supportive environment they need to excel. United Way of East Central Alabama is proud to continue this journey, creating pathways for youth opportunity and fostering resilience in our community!
